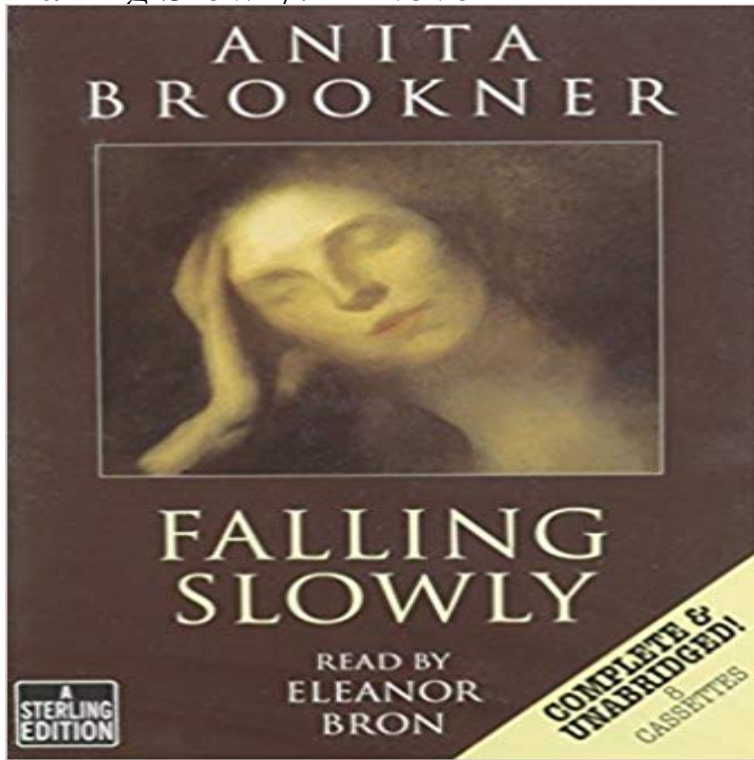


Falling Slowly: A Novel
