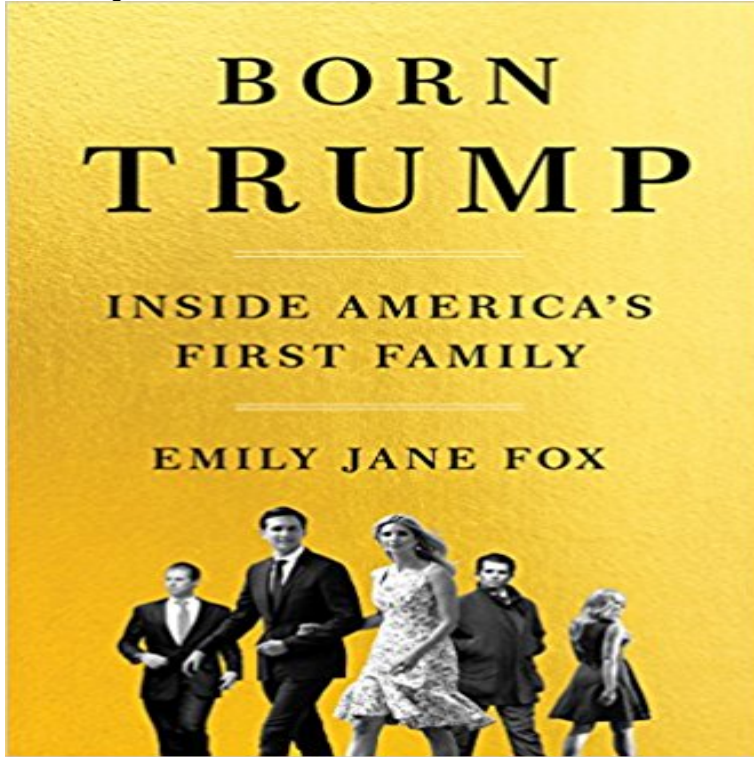


# Not Quite Mainstream: Canadian Jewish Short Stories
