

# Informed Consent For Blood Transfusion

**CONSENT TO BLOOD TRANSFUSION**

1. My doctor has informed me that I (may) need a transfusion of blood and/or one of its products for proper medical care.
2. My doctor or his/her representative (\_\_\_\_\_) has described to me the risks and benefits of receiving transfusion(s). These risks exist despite the fact that the blood has been carefully tested with all currently required screening tests. The principal side effects and hazards of blood transfusion include:
  - Febrile Reactions
  - Allergic Reactions
  - Transmission of Infectious Disease
  - Hemolytic Transfusion Reactions
3. This blood is evaluated according to all national standards. Additional research tests for blood safety may be performed on a sample of this blood.
4. The alternatives to transfusion, including the risks and consequences of not receiving this therapy, have been explained to me.
5. I have had the opportunity to ask questions, and I consent to the transfusion(s).
